Mr. Prashant Gaur serves as the Director of Enterprise Integration at the Defense Business Transformation Agency (BTA). In this role, he works with both the OSD and the services to drive the modernization and integration of business systems at the Department of Defense (DoD).

Prior to joining DoD, Mr. Gaur served as a Vice President and Partner at Unisys, where he was responsible for account management and delivering enterprise systems and infrastructure services to multiple federal agencies, including the General Services Administration. Mr. Gaur also served as Deputy to the CIO at the Internal Revenue Service, where he was responsible for business transformation initiatives and resolving critical issues such as implementation of enterprise architecture and the transition from legacy to modernized systems.

Mr. Gaur was also a Partner at PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC), where he led the establishment of enterprise resource planning and infrastructure practices for PwC in the federal sector. In addition, he led the business process reengineering and systems implementation of large financial and mission-critical systems for multiple defense and civilian agencies, including the Department of Navy and the Marine Corps. Prior to PwC, Mr. Gaur was a Director with a manufacturing consulting firm, where he led the implementation of supply chain systems for commercial clients such as WL Gore, manufacturer of spacesuits.

Mr. Gaur is very active in the industry and was elected Chair of the Emerging Technology Shared Interest Group of the Industry Advisory Council, where he led industry groups engaged with the government on issues such as acquisition of emerging technology and successful Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) implementation.

Mr. Gaur is a graduate of the Wharton Executive Education Program and received a fellowship for his Master's of Business Administration in finance and accounting from the University of Maryland. He received his undergraduate degree in Electrical Engineering from the prestigious Indian Institute of Technology, and is a certified Project Management Professional (PMP).
