Andrew Robinson has over 25 years of experience in strategic consulting, program management and solutions development. Andy serves ICF as Senior Vice President – Homeland Security and Program Management and is responsible for the management of over 50 programs and projects in Commercial, Civilian, Defense and Intelligence. He served as Executive Director of the Road Home Program Management Office. He was a speaker at the 07' PMI-World Congress and has appeared in magazines on the topic of Disaster Recovery and Program Management. He also serves on PMI's – Global Executive Council. Andy was elected to the board of the Industry Advisory Council (IAC) and has served as Member at Large responsible for PDAC, Programs and Congressional Education Working Group (CEWG) during his term.
